The Jackson/Nemaha Bullmasters will be hosting a shooting sports match for Archery. This match is a state qualifier. All levels of shooters are invited to participate from 4-H age 9 to 18.

NOTE: the minimum age to participate at the State Match 9 years old by Jan. 1, 2024

Registration forms and fees are due by Friday, August 9. Late registrations only accepted to fill flights. Fees are \$10 for the first bow, \$5 for a second bow per shooter. We will only accept registration from one person per county and this person will be notified of flight times. Registration will begin at 8:00 a.m., the first flight will begin at 9:00 a.m. - **each county needs to verify their shooter's information when checking in for correct age and bow type.** Awards will be given to the top 3 shooters in each of the different bow types. There will not be a concession stand, but we will have water available.

Shooters will shoot 24 arrows at 4 ft. FITA targets. Juniors (ages 9-13) will shoot 12 arrows at 30 meters and 12 arrows at 20 meters. Seniors (ages 14-18) will shoot 12 arrows at 40 meters and 12 arrows at 30 meters. Archers will be allowed 6 practice arrows at their farthest distance at the beginning of their flight. We will follow the World Archery Rulebook and state match rules.

Recurve – Bare Bow: 100 out of 240

Recurve – Olympic: 140 out of 240

Compound – Bow Hunter: 200 out of 240

Compound – OPEN: 210 out of 240

Shooters will score their arrows with the other shooters on the same target and must initial their scorecard before turning it in to the scoring room.
