Entry form and fees are **due by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 21, 2025**. Email to EllisCoordinator@outlook.com or mail Ellis Co. 4-H Shooting Sports Club, 601 Main Hays, KS 67601. **NO REFUNDS**. Late registration only accepted to fill relays. Check in and relay times will be sent to coordinators depending on number of entrants.

Fees will be \$15.00 per shooter, per discipline. Please send one entry form per county. Notification of relay times will be given to the contact information on the entry form. This will be a 4-H Kansas State Qualifier for Air Rifle and BB Gun. Match will be conducted following state match rules. The minimum age to PARTICIPATE at the State Match in air rifle and BB gun is 9 as of Jan. 1, 2025. We do not have a fun shoot for those under age. Age brackets for rifle and bb will be determined after receiving all registrations.

Air Rifle: Shooters will shoot 20 shot bulls in each of 3 positions (kneeling, prone, standing). Rules will follow the current CMP Sporter Air Rifle Rulebook. Individual awards will be given to the top five shooters in each age classification. Team awards will be given to the top three teams overall. To qualify for the State Match in air rifle, the minimum individual score is **450**. Awards given to top 3 shooters in age brackets 9-13 and 14-18 and top overall team combined.

BB Gun: Shooters will shoot 10 shot bulls in each of 4 positions (prone, standing, sitting, kneeling). Rules will follow the current NRA BB Gun Rulebook. Individual awards will be given to the top five Shooters in each age classification. Team awards will be given to the top 3 teams overall. To qualify for the State Match in BB Gun, the minimum individual score is **335**. BB gun will be determined by first shot down range (no shooter may be over 16 years old by the date of the match). Awards given to top 3 shooters in age brackets 9-11 and 12-15 and top overall team combined.

Air Rifle silhouette Fun Shoot: \$10 per participant age 9 and older. Following state format of chickens and pigs only. Will follow NRA rule book. Award provided to top shooter.
