The Western Plains Shooters will be hosting a shooting sports state qualifier match for BB Gun, Air Pistol, and Air Rifle. All levels of shooters are invited to participate from 4-H age 9 -18.

NOTE: the minimum age to participate at the State Match is:

- **9 years old before Jan. 1, 2025 for Air Rifle and BB Gun**
- **10 years old before Jan. 1, 2025 for Air Pistol**

Registration form and fees are due by 4:30 p.m. on February 12, 2025. Mail to Lisa Jacobus, 602 S. Freeman Ave., Oakley, KS 67748 or email to goldenprairieshooters@gmail.com. Late registration only accepted to fill relays. Check in and relay times will be sent to coordinators depending on number of shooters. We will only accept registration from **one person per county** and this person will be notified of relay times. Registration begins at 8 am, each county needs to verify their shooters information when checking in for correct age and disciplines. Orion Scoring system will be used to score BB Gun, Air Rifle, and Air Pistol.

Fees are \$15 per shooter, \$10 for any additional discipline. Concession stand will be available.

Jr & Sr Age Brackets will be determined after all registrations are turned in, except for air pistol.

Match will be conducted following state match rules.

BB Gun: Shooters will shoot 10 bull shots in each of the 4 positions. Rules will follow the current NRA BB Gun Rulebook. Individual Awards for BB Gun will be given to the top 3 shooters in Junior and Senior divisions. To qualify for the State Match in BB Gun, the minimum individual score is **335**. Everyone will shoot as an individual with the top 4 shooters from each county making up the team. Team awards will be given to the top 3 teams overall. Registration will be limited to the first **70** competitors in BB Gun.

Air Rifle: Shooters will shoot 20 bull shots in each of the 3 positions. Rules will follow the 2022-2024 CMP Sporter Air Rifle Rulebook. Individual Awards for Air Rifle will be given to the top 3 shooters in Junior and Senior divisions. To qualify for the State Match in air rifle, the minimum individual score is **450**. Everyone will shoot as an individual with the top 4 shooters from each county making up the team. Team awards will be given to the top 3 teams overall. Registration will be limited to the first **27** competitors in Air Rifle.

Air Pistol: Shooters will shoot 40 shots at 8 bulls (5 shots per bull) at 10 meters. Rules will follow the current USAS-NRA Progressive Air Pistol rulebook with the exception listed in the State Match Rules. *Juniors 10 – 13-year-olds will shoot one or two handed unsupported. Seniors 14 and over will shoot one handed unsupported.* To qualify for the State Match in air pistol, the minimum individual score is **280**. Individual Awards for Air Pistol will be given to the top 3 shooters in each age group. Everyone will shoot as an individual with the top 2 shooters from each county making up the team. Team awards will be given to the top 3 teams overall. Registration will be limited to the first **18** competitors in Air Pistols.
